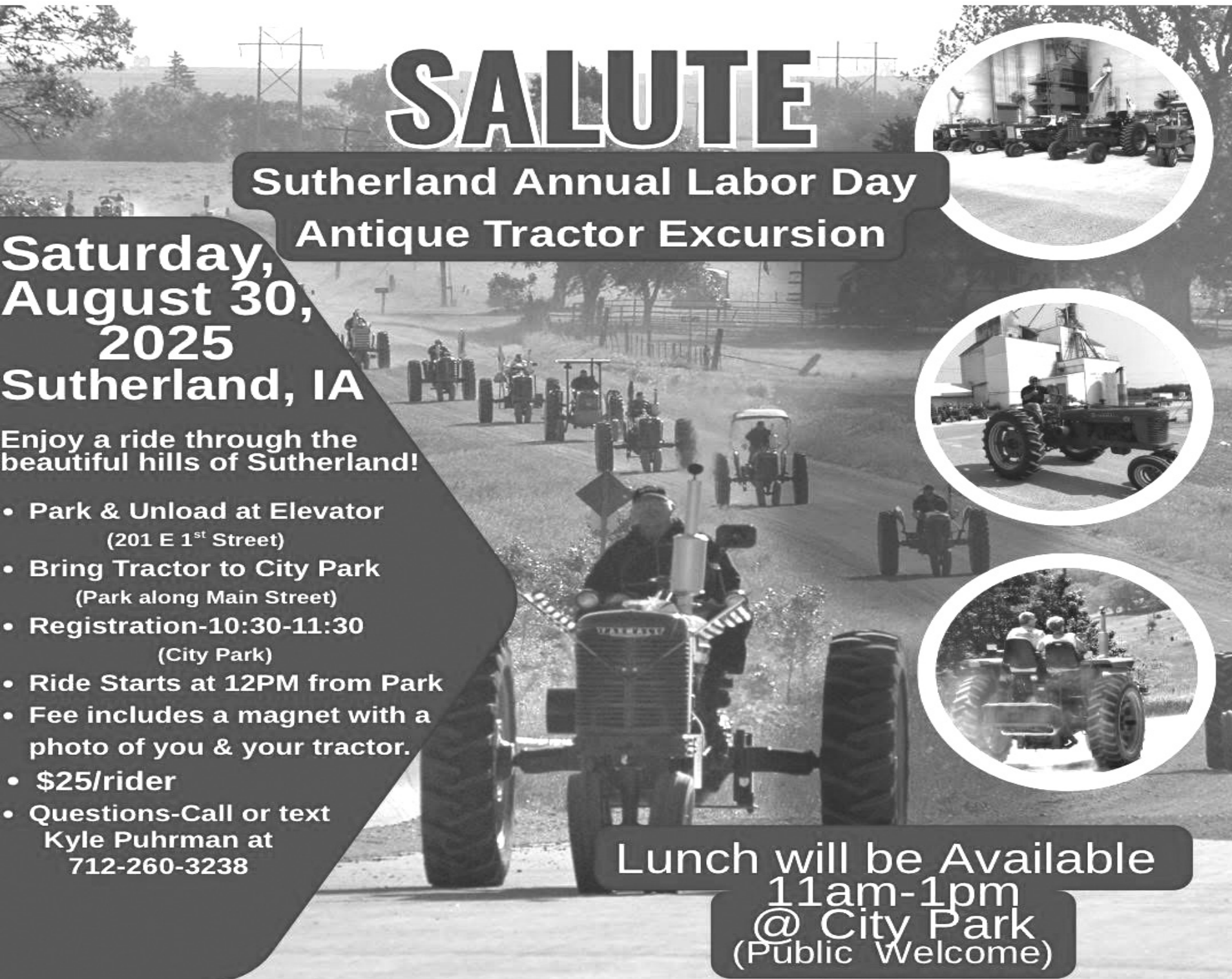

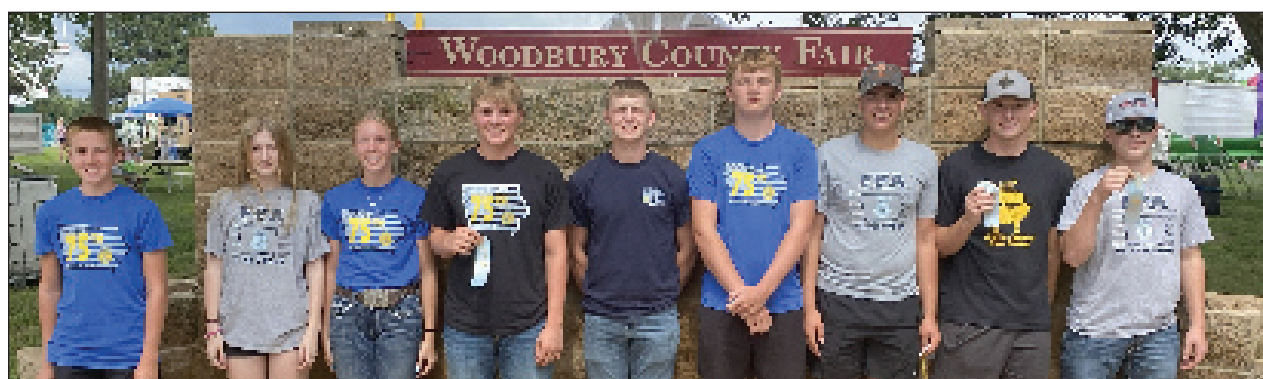
Competition continued at the Sac County Fair,
